

Privacy Policy

1. Purpose of the Privacy Policy

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to inform visitors to the France IX Services websites https://marketplace.franceix.net and https://portal.franceix.net as well as customers, prospects and partners of France IX Services on how their personal data is collected, used, and protected.

2. What is the role of France IX Services?

In the context of the management of our website and the relationship with our customers, prospects and partners, we act as a data controller. As such, we decide why (purposes) and how (means) your data is collected and used.

3. How is your personal data collected?

- Directly via forms: We collect the Personal Data that you provide to us directly through forms: for example, when you subscribe to our newsletter, request information about our services, or participate in an event organized by France IX Services. This includes contact data such as surname/first name or email address, as well as any other information that you wish to bring to our attention (services which interest you, etc.) or data that you spontaneously communicate to us by contacting our teams or during our exchanges.
- Indirectly through business partners who may provide us with information about you, such as your contact information.
- Also, some of your data is collected automatically, through cookies. To find out more, see our cookie policy.

4. For what purpose and for how long do we use your personal data?

The table below summarises all the processing operations for which France IX Services may use your personal data.

5. Who is your personal data intended for?

The Personal Data collected may be communicated to the following categories of recipients, in compliance with the applicable regulations:

Within France IX Services (internal recipients)

Your Personal Data is processed by authorized members of France IX Services' staff.

Outside France IX Services (external recipients)

Several categories of third parties listed below may have access to your Personal Data. Only the Personal Data that is strictly necessary is transmitted to them.

- Our service providers are involved in the delivery of services (NOC, service provider carrying out interventions in Dacacenter, etc.).
- Our marketing service providers (marketing agency, tools used to send targeted marketing communications or data analysis or segmentation of the prospect base, referencing management and solution for enriching and validating professional contacts) and cookie storage tools (Matomo: https://fr.matomo.org/privacy-policy/).
- Our event providers: tools used for registration and tracking of events you attend.
- Your data may be transmitted to our CRM (customer relationship management tool:
 Hubspot: https://legal.hubspot.com/fr/privacy-policy), to our email solution for the
 purpose of communicating with you (Gmail: https://policies.google.com/privacy?hl=fr CA) and to our online file storage or sharing solution (Dropbox: https://www.dropbox.com/fr/privacy).



We ensure that these subcontractors contractually commit to implementing a level of protection equivalent to ours and in accordance with the Regulation.

Special case of data sharing:

France IX Services undertakes not to transmit your Personal Data to third parties unless:

- You have given your prior consent to the sharing of your Personal Data with these third parties,
- Sharing your Personal Data with these third parties is necessary for the provision of the requested services,
- A competent judicial or administrative authority requires that the Data be transmitted to it.

6. How your data is used by third-party platforms

Our website may contain links to other websites over which we have no control. We encourage you to read the privacy policies of the websites and apps you may interact with.

7. Transfer outside the EU

We prefer to store your Personal Data within the European Union as much as possible. For example, our servers are located within the European Union.

However, we may use service providers who process the information we provide to them outside the European Union. When this occurs, we ensure that the recipient offers appropriate guarantees to process your information with a level of protection that meets GDPR requirements (in particular, through the use of the European Commission's Standard Contractual Clauses, which the CNIL has recognized as ensuring an adequate level of protection for privacy and fundamental rights).

As part of our work organization (office automation tools, accounting software, etc.) or to manage exchanges with our prospects and customers (CRM, satisfaction surveys, etc.), we also use free or paid digital tools or services developed by American companies. The use of these tools is currently based on the new self-certification system for American entities implemented on July 10, 2023 (Data Privacy Framework).

We have verified that the organizations concerned (HubSpot, Oracle, Google and Dropbox) are on the list of certified organizations made available on the website of the United States Department of Commerce (https://www.dataprivacyframework.gov/s/participant-search). By making an annual and public commitment to adhere to this legal framework and to respect all its principles, these companies are considered to offer guarantees similar to those of the European Union.

Finally, in order to allow the transfer consisting of remote access of an employee based in a country located outside the European Union, we have ensured that this transfer is carried out with an adequate level of protection: this country benefits from an adequacy decision and is considered fully adequate by the European Commission.



8. What are your rights regarding your personal data?

a) Right of access

You can request and obtain information about the personal data we hold about you.

b) Right to rectification

You have the right to request the correction of your inaccurate or incomplete personal data.

c) Right to erasure

Also known as the "right to be forgotten", it allows you to request the deletion of your personal data unless the data must be retained:

- to comply with a legal obligation,
- for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

d) Right to restriction of processing

This right allows you to request to limit the use of your personal data in certain circumstances:

- You have requested the rectification of your data, the processing may then be limited to the time it takes to verify the accuracy of your personal data;
- The processing is unlawful and you object to the erasure of your data (you request the restriction of their use instead);
- The data controller no longer needs your data for the purposes of the processing, but it is necessary for you to establish, exercise or defend a legal claim;
- You have objected to the processing and we will check whether our legitimate grounds prevail over your grounds.

e) Right to data portability

You may receive your personal data in a structured, machine-readable format, in order to transfer it to another organization.

f) Right to object

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data on legitimate grounds, unless there are compelling legitimate grounds to continue processing.

Several processing of your personal data are subject to your consent. You can remove it at any time.

g) Right to make a complaint to the CNIL

You also have the right to submit a complaint to the CNIL, the supervisory authority (www.cnil.fr).



9. How to exercise your rights?

a) Procedures for exercising rights

You can submit your requests in the following ways:

b) Response time

France IX Services has a period of one month to respond to you from the receipt of your request. This period may be extended by two months due to the complexity of your request and the number of requests made to us; in this case you will be informed.
