



Importance of the Mediterranean region

- Development of 9 future cable projects:
 Medloop, Blue Raman, Teas...
- Around 50% of the world's population and 45% of the world's economy within 6,000 km of the center of the Mediterranean
- 140% annual growth in digital usage worldwide: AI, blockchain, analytics.
- Traffic could triple from here to Marseille by 2027
